

# **Rodney Ratliff Scholarship**

## **College of Business & Technology**

### **Eastern Kentucky University**

The Rodney Ratliff Scholarship will be granted annually to a student or students at the beginning of the junior year (completed 60 hours or more) in the College of Business & Technology who demonstrates exceptional character, scholarship, leadership and professionalism as selected by the Executive Council in the College of Business & Technology.

Mr. Rodney Ratliff, EKU Business Alumnus Class of 1955, established this scholarship to provide financial aid to promising College of Business and Technology students in a manner to be deemed by the College as best fitting the needs of their students. The CBT Executive Council has thus outlined the awarding process and qualifications below.

#### **Qualifications:**

To be considered for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be enrolled as a full-time student in the College of Business & Technology at Eastern Kentucky University
- Have at least 3 semesters remaining before the completions of a degree in the College of Business & Technology at the time of the Scholarship Award
- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 or above
- Complete the Rodney Ratliff Scholarship Application by December 1 and return to respective department chair.

#### **Method of Selection:**

The recipient(s) will be selected on a competitive basis by the Executive Council in the College of Business & Technology. The committee will work in cooperation with the University's Scholarship Office and the Office of Financial Affairs in awarding the scholarship. This is a one-time award, however, recipients can reapply for their senior year.

#### **Conditions of Scholarship:**

The scholarship recipient(s) must maintain a 3.0 GPA during his or her Junior year and make normal progress toward a degree in the College of Business & Technology. Normal progress is defined as successful completion of 24 semester credit hours or more per year. A student who fails to make normal progress toward the degree or does not maintain satisfactory academic standards may have the scholarship revoked, but may re-apply when deficiencies are corrected.

#### **Application for the Rodney Ratliff Scholarship:**

All applicants must:

- Complete the application form and submit a letter of application outlining any qualifications (honors, service, extra-curricular activities, etc.) that the applicant would like to be considered by the Executive Council. Deadline for submission is December 1.
- Submit a resume and an unofficial transcript of all college work
